Appointment of McIntosh Operations Manager

McIntosh Project Progress

The infographic below shows the path to production for the McIntosh Project, subject to relevant approvals and funding, with environmental site surveys completed and environmental approvals almost completed.



An Indicated and inferred JORC resource has been announced for McIntosh Target 1, and JORC resource estimations are imminent for Targets 2, 5 and 6.

A Scoping Study for the McIntosh Project is being progressed with its key parameters having recently been upgraded based on positive technical results, including the successful bulk sample trial announced on 6 May 2014.

Retirement of Director

As a result of the focus on development and production for the McIntosh Project, Dr Craig Rugless has retired from the Board to focus his energies on the successful processing of commercial flake graphite from McIntosh. Dr Rugless drilled the discovery RAB holes at McIntosh, initially in 1993, and along with his small team, has been instrumental in realising the



potential of this world class flake graphite property for Lamboo. Craig will continue to serve as a senior member of the team in executing the Company's strategy.
